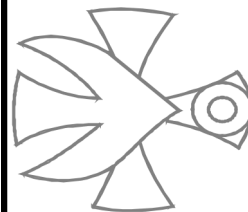

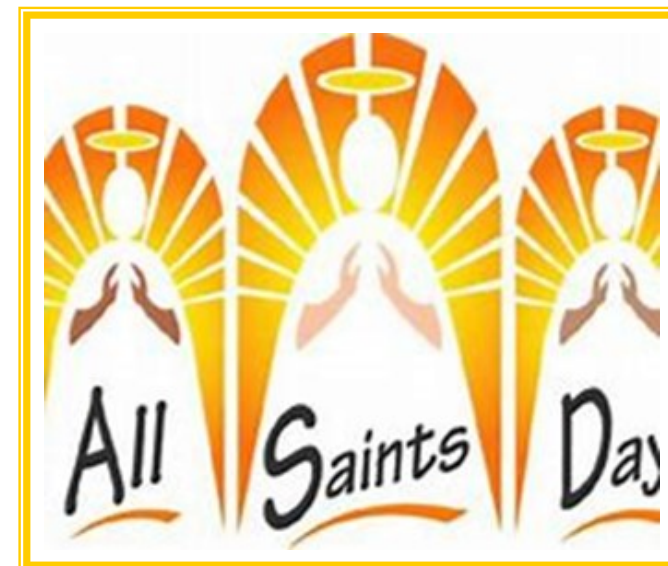

For I am about to create new heavens and a

remembered or come to mind. But be glad and
rejoice for ever in what I am creating; for I am

about to create Jerusalem as a joy, and its
people as a delight. I will rejoice in Jerusalem,
and delight in my people; no more shall the
sound of weeping be heard in it,
or the cry of distress. No more shall there be in it
an infant that lives but a few days, or an old
person who does not live out a lifetime; for one
who dies at a hundred years will be considered a
youth, and one who falls short of a hundred will
be considered accursed.

They shall not labour in vain, or bear children for
calamity; for they shall be offspring blessed by

they call I will answer, while they are yet
speaking I will hear. The wolf and the lamb shall
