

A READING FROM MICAH, CHAPTER 4,

mountains, and shall be raised up above
the hills. Peoples shall stream to it, and many
nations shall come and say: 'Come, let us go up
to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the
God of Jacob; that he may teach us his ways

and that we may walk in his paths.' For out of
Zion shall go forth instruction, and the word of
the Lord from Jerusalem. He shall judge
between many peoples, and shall arbitrate
between strong nations far away; they shall beat
their swords into ploughshares, and their spears
into pruning-hooks; nation shall not lift up sword
against nation, neither shall they learn war
any more; but they shall all sit under their own
vines and under their own fig trees, and no one
shall make them afraid; for the mouth of
the Lord of hosts has spoken.

A READING FROM THE BOOK OF PSALMS:

Psalm 46

- .1. God is our refuge and strength:
a very present help in trouble.
2. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth
be moved:
**and though the mountains are shaken
in the midst of the sea;**
3. Though the waters rage and form:
**and though the mountains quake at the
rising of the sea.**
4. There is a river whose streams make glad
the city of God:
**the holy dwelling-place of the Most
High.**
5. God is in the midst of her,
therefore she shall not be moved:
God will help her, and at break of day.
6. The nations make uproar, and the
kingdoms are shaken:
**but God has lifted his voice, and the
earth shall tremble.**
7. *The Lord of hosts is with us:*
the God of Jacob is our stronghold.
8. Come then and see what the Lord has
done:

**what destruction he has brought upon
the earth.**

9. He makes wars to cease in all the world:
**he breaks the bow and shatters the
spear,
and burns the chariots in the fire.**
10. 'Be still, and know that I am God:
**I will be exalted among the nations,
I will be exalted upon the earth.'**
11. *The Lord of hosts is with us:*
the God of Jacob is our stronghold.

A READING FROM THE LETTER TO THE HEBREWS,
CHAPTER 10, VERSES 32 - CHAPTER 11, VERSE 1:

But recall those earlier days when, after you had
been enlightened, you endured a hard struggle
with sufferings, sometimes being publicly
exposed to abuse and persecution, and
sometimes being partners with those so
treated. For you had compassion for those who
were in prison, and you cheerfully accepted the
plundering of your possessions, knowing that
you yourselves possessed something better and
more lasting. Do not, therefore, abandon that
confidence of yours; it brings a great reward. For
you need endurance, so that when you have
done the will of God, you may receive what was
promised.

For yet 'in a very little while,
the one who is coming will
come and will not delay;
but my righteous one will live by
faith.
My soul takes no pleasure in
anyone who shrinks back.'

But we are not among those who shrink back
and so are lost, but among those who have faith
and so are saved.

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for,
the conviction of things not seen.

THE GOSPEL OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST
ACCORDING TO JOHN, CHAPTER 15,
VERSES 9-17:

Glory to you Lord Jesus Christ

As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you;
abide in my love. If you keep my commandments,
you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my
Father's commandments and abide in his love. I
have said these things to you so that my joy may
be in you, and that your joy may be complete.
'This is my commandment, that you love one
another as I have loved you. No one has greater
love than this, to lay down one's life for one's
friends. You are my friends if you do what I
command you. I do not call you servants any
longer, because the servant does not know what
the master is doing; but I have called you friends,
because I have made known to you everything
that I have heard from my Father. You did not
choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you
to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the
Father will give you whatever you ask him in my
name. I am giving you these commands so that
you may love one another.
